BURN PERMIT

Please read the following rules and regulations that are conditions of the issuance of this permit as expressly set forth below.

- Conduct outdoor burning in accordance with International Fire Prevention Code and the special provisions that have been stated by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- The Liberty Fire Department SHALL be notified at least 1 hour in advance of any burning.
- Contact with TCEQ outdoor burning hot line shall be made prior to any burning at TCEQ 713-767-3714.
- Burning shall not begin earlier than 1 hour before sunrise and end not later than 1 hour before sunset.
- Burning shall not be commenced when surface wind speed is predicted to be less than six miles per hour or greater than 23 miles per hour during the burn period.
- Only limbs shall be burned no leaves, pine needles, stumps or domestic waste shall be allowed to be burned.
- Fire shall be extinguished daily; no items are allowed to be left smoldering overnight.
- Burning shall be at least 300 feet from any roadway or structure that is adjacent to the burning area.
- Burning shall only be allowed under these conditions and conditions of TCEQ Sec. 111.219 "General Requirements for Allowable Outdoor Burning."
- Burning SHALL cease if it becomes a nuisance or if any outdoor burning bans are placed into effect.

- Burning SHALL cease if health warnings are in place from ANY agency of the State of Texas.
- This permit is NOT transferable and any changes in use or occupancy of a building or premises shall require a new permit.
- This permit may be revoked for the terms and conditions under which same was granted, and/or violations of the International Fire Prevention Code of the City of Liberty, Texas.
- Termination of this permit WILL occur if any of the provisions are not adhered to.
- A citation MAY be issued if any provisions are not adhered to.
- The Fire Marshal or his duly appointed agent(s) may revoke this permit.
